AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTED CITY OFFICIALS, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1996, AND AMENDING SECTION 3.08.010 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 3.08.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.08.010 Salaries -- Elected officials (councilmember, mayor).

The salaries for elected officials are established to be as follows:
Councilmember: \$500.00 per month.

The councilmember serving as mayor shall, while so serving, receive an additional \$150.00 per month, provided-that-effective-January-1, 1987,-said-additional-amount-shall-be \$200.00-per-month.

The individuals holding the offices for which salaries are herein established shall be entitled to receive such salaries commencing with the month of January 1990 1996. Until said date, elected officials shall continue to receive the salaries established by Ordinance No. 2000 3025 adopted June 17,-1985 15, 1987.

In addition to the stated salary, council members,-beginning-January 1990, may to the same extent as other general city employees participate in any life insurance program, as may be established by the city for city employees (other than by collective bargaining contract). Prior-to January-1990-council-members-may-elect to-so-participate,-but-at-their personal-expense-only.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its

passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
