

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES AND AMENDING KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 12.44.080.

Whereas, the City Council finds that traffic safety concerns and the need for mitigation of vehicle related impacts on a residential neighborhood make it in the public interest to restrict parking in an area near Juanita High School; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. KMC Section 12.44.080, entitled Restricted Parking Zones Established, is hereby amended by the addition of a new zone 18 to read as follows:

Zone 18 No parking - 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., School Days, except by Zone 18 permit, on both sides of the specified portion of the following streets: 111th Avenue NE between NE 128th Street and NE 132nd Street; NE 131st Street between 110th Avenue NE and 111th Avenue NE; 110th Avenue NE between NE 128th Street and NE 131st Street; NE 128th Street between 110th Avenue NE and 112th Place NE; and NE 128th Street West of 110th Avenue NE to a line which is the southerly extension of the western boundary of the power line easement which lies west of and parallel to 110th Avenue NE.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.


