ORDINANCE 3414

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PARKING METERS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> There is hereby created a new section to be known as Section 12.04.050 and to read as follows:

12.04.050 Parking meter revenue.

The coins required to be deposited in parking meters as provided in Chapter 12.44 are levied and assessed as fees to cover the costs of installations, inspections, supervision, regulation and maintenance involved in the control of traffic and parking upon the streets and the duly authorized agents of the Director of Administration and Finance shall, from time to time, collect, and deposit the same in the a special fund for parking revenue, as directed by the Director of Administration and Finance.

<u>Section 2.</u> Section 12.44.050 of the Kirkland Municipal Code entitled "Restricted parking zones - Definitions," is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.44.050 Restricted parking zones— Definitions.

For the purpose of Sections 12.44.060 through 12.44.100:

 (1) "Operator" means every person who is in actual physical control of a vehicle as herein defined, upon a public street or highway of the city;

(2) "Overnight parking" means the parking of a vehicle in one spot continuously for a period exceeding six hours at any time during the hours from ten p.m. of the day designated to eight a.m. of the following day;

(3) "Parking meter" means a coin-operated timing device placed or erected adjacent to a parking space which, after deposit of specified coinage and activation of the timer, where required, measures the period of time that occupancy of such parking space is allowed;

(3)(4) "Person" means every natural person, firm, copartnership, corporation, association or organization;

(5) "Service parking meter hood" means a device to cover a parking meter while the parking space is being utilized for service parking.

(4)(6) "Street" or "public street" includes all public ways, streets, highways and off-street parking facilities owned or maintained by the City;

(5)(7) "Vehicle" means every device capable of being moved upon a public highway and in, upon, or by which any person, or property, shall or may be transported or drawn upon any public highway excepting devices moved by human power.

Section 3. Section 12.44.060 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, entitled "Restricted parking zones - Designation - Violation unlawful," is hereby amended as follows:

12.44.060 Restricted parking zones DesignationParking Restrictions—Violations unlawful

Such-streets of the City as the <u>The</u> chief of police and the traffic engineer, by and with the consent of the city council, may from time to time designate are designated and established portions of streets of the <u>City</u> as restricted parking zones <u>and/or parking meter</u> <u>spaces.</u> and <u>It</u> is unlawful for any person to park or stand a vehicle or vehicles on those streets within the zones in violation of the provisions of this section and Sections 12.44.070 through 12.44.100 <u>or to park a</u> <u>vehicle in any parking meter space for a consecutive</u> <u>period of time longer than that limited period of time for</u> which parking is lawfully permitted in the parking meter, <u>space as indicated in the legend on the parking meter</u>, <u>irrespective of the number or amounts of the coins</u> <u>deposited in such meter</u>.

Section 4. Section 12.44.070 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, entitled "Overtime parking—Violations," is hereby amended as follows:

12.44.070 Overtime parking—Violations.

(a) No person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle under his or her control to be or remain parked on the streets in violation of parking zone restrictions or the provisions of Sections 12.44.070 through 12.44.100.

(b) No person shall stop, stand, or park, or permit a vehicle within his control to be parked in any

space upon a street alongside of and next to a parking meter in any of the following circumstances, provided that this subsection shall not apply to the act of parking or the time necessary to activate the timer on the parking meter:

(1) Unless a coin or coins of United States Currency of the appropriate denomination or City of Kirkland parking meter token, as indicated in the legend on the meter, shall have been deposited therein, or shall have been previously deposited therein for an unexpired interval of time, and the meter has been placed in operation; or

 (2) While the parking meter for such space displays the words "Violation," or "Expired;" or
(3) For a consecutive period of time longer than that limited period of time for which parking is lawfully permitted as indicated on the legend on the parking meter, irrespective of the number or amounts of the coins deposited in such meter.

(c) For imposition of the penalties provided in Section 12.44.085, there shall be a prima facie presumption that the registered owner of the violator vehicle at the time of the violation was the person who parked such vehicle. (Ord. 3377 § 2, 1993)

<u>Section 5.</u> There is hereby created a new section to be known as Section 12.44.096 and to read as follows:

12.44.096 Illegal Use—Parking Meters

It is a traffic infraction, with a monetary penalty of one hundred dollars, for any person to deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter, any slug, button, or any other device or substance as substitutes for coins of the United States or City of Kirkland parking tokens.

<u>Section 6.</u> There is hereby created a new section to be known as Section 12.44.097 and to read as follows:

12.44.097 Meter - Hooded.

It is a traffic infraction, with a monetary penalty of one hundred dollars, for any person, without proper authority, to stop, stand or park a vehicle where the parking meter is covered by a service parking meter hood.

Section 7. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, part or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication pursuant to Section 1.08.017 of the Kirkland Municipal Code in summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council, as required by law.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 3414

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PARKING METERS.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Adds a new subsection 12.04.050 which provides for collection and administration of parking meter revenue.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. Amends subsection 12.44.050 to include definitions of parking meter and service parking meter hood.

SECTION 3. Amends subsection 12.44.060 to define and include parking meter restrictions and violation.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. Amends subsection 12.44.070 to define and include overtime parking violations in relationship to parking meter spaces.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Adds a new subsection 12.44.096 which defines illegal use of parking meters as a traffic infraction with a monetary penalty.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. Adds a new subsection 12.44.097 which defines parking at a hooded meter as a traffic infraction with a monetary penalty.

SECTION 7. Contains a savings clause.

<u>SECTION 8.</u> Authorizes publication of the ordinance by summary, which summary is approved by the City Council, pursuant to section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code, and establishes the effective date as five days after publication of summary.
