A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST, EXCEPT FOR A UTILITY EASEMENT, THE CITY MAY HAVE IN UNOPENED RIGHT-OF-WAY AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNER COREY SOLLOM.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to recognize that any
 rights the City may have to the land originally dedicated in 1891 as right of-way abutting a portion of Supplementary Plat To Kirkland have been
 vacated by operation of law; and

6 WHEREAS, under Washington State's Non-User Statute, Laws of
7 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, any county road that remained unopened
8 for five years after authority was granted for opening the same was
9 statutorily vacated by operation of law; and

11 WHEREAS, the area that is the subject of this request was part 12 of an annexation to the City of Kirkland in 1905, with the relevant right-13 of-way having been unopened and remaining unopened; and 14

WHEREAS, in consideration for the abutting property owner granting the City a utility easement in the unopened right-of-way area and for reimbursing the City administrative costs for reviewing the request, the City is willing to recognize the statutory vacation may have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of theCity of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby recognizes that the following described right-of-way may have been statutorily vacated by operation of law and the City relinquishes all interest, except for a utility easement to be recorded following this resolution, that the City may have in that portion of right-of-way described as follows:

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The south 8 feet of the unopened alley, or whatever portion remains for recognition of possible vacation by this Resolution, abutting the north boundary of the following described property: Lots 44, 45, and 46, Block 240, Supplementary Plat to Kirkland, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Volume 8 of Plats, page 5, in King County, Washington.

 39 in the property, if any.
