ORDINANCE NO. 3430

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO MARINE VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS THE STATE OF WASHINGTON HAS DECRIMINALIZED MOST MINOR BOATING VIOLATIONS; AND,

WHEREAS KMC 1.04.010(d) PROVIDES FOR MAXIMUM PENALTIES THAT DO NOT EXCEED STATE LAW.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

- Section 1. There is hereby created a new section to be known as KMC 1.04.010(e) to read as follows:
- (e) Notwithstanding the penalties established by this chapter, unless specified otherwise, violation of any section contained in Title 14 of this code and section 11.80.110 are civil infractions and the penalty for violation shall be an amount established for such violation by ordinance or court rule.
- Section 2. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not effected.
- Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
