AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE CRIMINAL CODE, FIREARMS AND WEAPONS, LIMITATIONS ON OPEN CARRY OF FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS, AND ADOPTING A REFERENCE TO RCW 9.31.305 TO ADD A MISDEMEANOR CRIME TO THE CRIMINAL CODE.

WHEREAS, Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1630 (ESHB 1630), Chapter 106, Laws of 2022 and now codified in relevant part at RCW 9.41.305, went into effect on June 9, 2022 and makes it unlawful and a misdemeanor crime for any person to knowingly open carry a firearm or other weapon, as defined by RCW 9.41.300(1)(b), while knowingly being in any city buildings used in connection with a governing body of the city, or any location of a public meeting or hearing of a governing body of the city; and

WHEREAS, RCW 9.41.305 law does not apply to law enforcement officers when carrying a firearm or other weapon in conformance with department policy, or to members of the armed forces in the discharge of their officials duties; and

WHEREAS, RCW 9.41.300(1)(b) defines "weapons" as any firearm, explosive as defined in RCW 70.74.010, or any weapon of the kind usually known as slungshot, sand club, or metal knuckles, or any knife, dagger, dirk, or other similar weapon that is capable of causing death or bodily injury and is commonly used with the intent to cause death or bodily injury; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to HB 1630 and RCW 42.30.020 of the Washington Open Public Meetings Act, "governing body" is defined to include the Kirkland City Council and any other City multimember board, commission, committee, council, or other policy or rule-making body or any committee thereof when the committee acts on behalf the governing body, conducts hearings, or takes testimony or public comment; and

WHEREAS, a person violating RCW 9.41.305 is guilty of a misdemeanor for a first violation and a gross misdemeanor for second and subsequent violations; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to add RCW 9.41.305 to its identification of adopted RCW sections in Article 11, Criminal Code, of the Kirkland Municipal Code in order that misdemeanor violations of RCW 9.41.305 may be prosecuted in the Kirkland Municipal Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 11.12.040 is amended to read as follows:

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication pursuant to Section 1.08.017, Kirkland Municipal Code in the summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council.

## PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4799

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE CRIMINAL CODE, FIREARMS AND WEAPONS, LIMITATIONS ON OPEN CARRY OF FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS, AND ADOPTING A REFERENCE TO RCW 9.31.305 TO ADD A MISDEMEANOR CRIME TO THE CRIMINAL CODE.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Amends Kirkland Municipal Code Section 11.12.040 related to crimes and punishments adopted by reference.

SECTION 2. Provides a severability clause for the ordinance.

SECTION 3. Authorizes publication of the ordinance by summary, which summary is approved by the City Council pursuant to Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code and establishes the effective date as five days after publication of summary.
