AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO FLOOD HAZARD AND FLOOD HAZARD INSURANCE. ADOPTING THE FLOOD INSURANCE STUDY FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND UNDER THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM, HAVING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF MAY 16, 1995, AND AMENDING SECTION 21.56.050 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 21.56.050 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

21.56.050 basis for establishing the areas of special flood hazard.

The areas of special flood hazard identified by the Federal Insurance Administration in a scientific and engineering report entitled "The Flood Insurance Study for the City of Kirkland" Dated [~~December 15, 1980~~ September 30, 1993, having an effective date of May 16, 1995, with accompanying flood assurance maps as adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this chapter. The flood insurance study is on file at City Hall, 123 Fifth Avenue, Kirkland, WA, 98033.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
