ORDINANCE 0-4813

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REQUIRING THAT THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION ESTABLISH A TWO-YEAR WORK PLAN AND MEET WITH CITY COUNCIL AT LEAST ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS TO DISCUSS THE WORK PLAN.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 3.45.040 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

3.45.040 Powers and duties of commission.

The commission is directed by the city council to advise the public works department, city manager, and city council in leading the city's efforts to create and maintain a transportation system that enhances the economic, social, and environmental quality of life in our city now and into the future. To fulfill its mission, the commission will work with the public works department to establish a two-year n annual work plan that which proactively explores, investigates, analyzes, prioritizes, develops, and recommends solutions and actions to the city manager and city council. The city council and commission will meet at least once every two years annually to discuss the two-year annual work plan for adoption by council.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
