

ORDINANCE O-4813

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REQUIRING THAT THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION ESTABLISH A TWO-YEAR WORK PLAN AND MEET WITH CITY COUNCIL AT LEAST ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS TO DISCUSS THE WORK PLAN.

1           The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

3           Section 1. Section 3.45.040 of the Kirkland Municipal Code  
4 is amended to read as follows:


6           **3.45.040 Powers and duties of commission.**

7           The commission is directed by the city council to advise the public  
8 works department, city manager, and city council in leading the  
9 city's efforts to create and maintain a transportation system that  
10 enhances the economic, social, and environmental quality of life  
11 in our city now and into the future. To fulfill its mission, the  
12 commission will work with the public works department to  
13 establish a two-year ~~n-annual~~ work plan that ~~which~~ proactively  
14 explores, investigates, analyzes, prioritizes, develops, and  
15 recommends solutions and actions to the city manager and city  
16 council. The city council and commission will meet at least once  
17 every two years ~~annually~~ to discuss the two-year ~~annual~~ work plan  
18 for adoption by council.  
19

20           Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five  
21 days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and  
22 publication, as required by law.


