ORDINANCE 0-4819

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING SECTION 15.24.070 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE SEWER SYSTEM CUSTOMER RATES FOR 2023 AND 2024.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 15.24.070 of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC"), as last amended by Ordinance 4737 (2020), which contains a table that establishes the monthly sewer charge required to be paid to the City by customers of the Kirkland Sewer System, is hereby amended to read as follows, with new text shown in underline and deleted text shown in strikethrough:

15.24.070 Monthly volume-based sewer rates.

- The monthly sewer charge required to be paid to the city by customers of the Kirkland sewer system is established in Table 15.24.070.
- Annually, the city will calculate each single-family residential customer's average winter water consumption ("AWWC"). The resulting AWWC will be the basis for such customer's monthly sewer rate for the following calendar year.
- The director of public works is authorized to adopt administrative procedures for the purpose of administering the provisions of this chapter, including the procedure for annual calculation of average winter water consumption.

- B. The 2023 monthly service and consumption rates established in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 3, number 6, and number 8 (whose annual billing cycle is December 1 through November 30) shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of December 1, 2022.
- C. The 2023 monthly service and consumption rates established in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 2, number 4, and number 5 (whose annual billing cycle is January 1 through December 31) shall go into effect January 1, 2023.
- D. The 2024 monthly service and consumption rates established in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 3, number 6, and number 8 (whose annual billing cycle is December 1 through November 30) shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of December 1, 2023.
- E. The 2024 monthly service and consumption rates established in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 2, number 4, and number 5 (whose annual billing cycle is January 1 through December 31) shall go into effect January 1, 2024.
- <u>Section 3</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.
- <u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication pursuant to Section 1.08.017 of the Kirkland Municipal Code in the summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council.

PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4819

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING SECTION 15.24.070 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE SEWER SYSTEM CUSTOMER RATES FOR 2023 AND 2024.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Amends Section 15.24.070 of the Kirkland Municipal Code related to monthly sewer charges.

SECTION 2. Provides an effective date for the rates.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Provides a severability clause for the ordinance.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. Authorizes publication of the ordinance by summary, which summary is approved by the City Council pursuant to Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code and establishes the effective date as five days after publication of summary.

The full text of this Ordinance will be mailed without charge to any person upon request made to the City Clerk for the City of Kirkland. The Ordinance was passed by the Kirkland City Council at its meeting on the 18 day of October, 2022.
