## ORDINANCE O-4820

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING SECTION 15.56.020 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE MONTHLY SURFACE WATER UTILITY SERVICE RATES FOR 2023 AND 2024.

1 The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as 2 follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 15.56.020 of the Kirkland Municipal
 Code, as last amended by Ordinance No. O-4738 (2020), is hereby
 amended to read as follows, with new text shown in <u>underline</u> and
 deleted text shown in <del>strikethrough</del>:

7 15.56.020 Monthly surface water utility service rates.
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9 <u>2023 Rates, effective beginning January 1, 2023</u>: Effective
 10 <del>2021</del>:

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12 The monthly surface water utility rates are based on the 13 impervious surface area.

(1) Single-Family Residential Parcels. The average impervious
area for a single-family residence is two thousand six hundred
square feet. This is based on the measurement of over three
hundred parcels. This value is referred to as an equivalent service
unit (ESU). The single-family service charge shall be equivalent to
one ESU and shall be a flat rate of eighteen dollars and eightyone cents nineteen dollars and seventy-five cents.

(2) All other Customers, Including Commercial and Multifamily 21 Residential. The service charge for all classes other than single-22 family residences will be based on the number of ESUs. The actual 23 measured impervious area of each individual site will be divided 24 by two thousand six hundred square feet to determine the number 25 of ESUs of the individual site. The computed rate shall not be less 26 than that for one ESU. The surface water utility service rate for 27 these customers shall be eighteen dollars and eighty one cents 28 nineteen dollars and seventy-five cents per each ESU. 29

30 (3) Late Fees. All fees and charges arising under this chapter
31 which are past due or delinquent shall be charged a late fee of
32 eight percent per annum.

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34 2024 Rates, effective beginning January 1, 2024: Effective 2022:

The monthly surface water utility rates are based on the impervious surface area.

(1) Single-Family Residential Parcels. The average impervious
area for a single-family residence is two thousand six hundred
square feet. This is based on the measurement of over three
hundred parcels. This value is referred to as an equivalent service
unit (ESU). The single-family service charge shall be equivalent to
one ESU and shall be a flat rate of nineteen dollars and seventyfive cents twenty dollars and seventy-four cents.

(2) All other Customers, Including Commercial and Multifamily 44 Residential. The service charge for all classes other than single-45 46 family residences will be based on the number of ESUs. The actual measured impervious area of each individual site will be divided 47 by two thousand six hundred square feet to determine the number 48 of ESUs of the individual site. The computed rate shall not be less 49 than that for one ESU. The surface water utility service rate for 50 these customers shall be nineteen dollars and seventy-five cents 51 52 twenty dollars and seventy-four cents per each ESU.

(3) Late Fees. All fees and charges arising under this chapter
which are past due or delinquent shall be charged a late fee of
eight percent per annum.

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## Section 2. Effective Dates of Rates.

A. The surface water utility rates set forth in Ordinance No. O-4738
(2020), which is amended by this ordinance, shall remain in force and
effect until the new rates set forth in this ordinance go into effect.

B. The 2023 rates established in this ordinance shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of January 1, 2023.

63 C. The 2024 rates established in this ordinance shall go into effect64 and become the rates to be charged as of January 1, 2024.

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66 <u>Section 3</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its 67 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 68 remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to 69 other persons or circumstances is not affected.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five
 days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and
 publication pursuant to Section 1.08.017 of the Kirkland Municipal
 Code in the summary form attached to the original of this
 ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council.

## PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 4820

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING SECTION 15.56.020 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE MONTHLY SURFACE WATER UTILITY SERVICE RATES FOR 2023 AND 2024.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Amends Section 15.56.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code related to monthly surface water service rates.

SECTION 2. Provides an effective date for the rates.

SECTION 3. Provides a severability clause for the ordinance.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. Authorizes publication of the ordinance by summary, which summary is approved by the City Council pursuant to Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code and establishes the effective date as five days after publication of summary.
