

ORDINANCE O-4832

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO
2 CREATING THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES AND
3 AMENDING SECTION 3.16.037 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL
4 CODE.

6 WHEREAS, administrative departments of the City of
7 Kirkland ("City") are defined in Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC")
8 chapter 3.16 entitled "City Manager-Administrative Departments";
9 and

11 WHEREAS, chapter 3.16 KMC authorizes the City Manager
12 to organize the administrative offices and departments as the City
13 Manager determines will best serve the interests of the community
14 members of Kirkland; and

15
16 WHEREAS, at the November 1, 2022 City Council meeting,
17 the Council adopted Resolution R-5562, authorizing the formation
18 of the Regional Community Responder Agency (the "Agency") and
19 authorizing the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement
20 with four partner cities; and

21
22 WHEREAS, as part of such Interlocal Agreement, the City
23 will serve as the fiscal agent for the Agency, and all Agency
24 employees will be City employees; and

25
26 WHEREAS, all City employees are assigned to a department
27 with an assigned Director who may, with the concurrence of the
28 City Manager, establish within the department functional
29 divisions; and

30
31 WHEREAS, Agency employees will not sit within any
32 existing City department, and therefore a new department must
33 be created for Agency employees.

35 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland
36 do ordain as follows:

38 Section 1. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 3.16.037 is
39 amended as follows.

41 **3.16.037 Other departments.**



43 In addition to the foregoing, there shall be the following
44 departments: parks and community services, planning and
45 building, fire, public works, city attorney's office, information
46 technology, ~~and human resources, and general services.~~ The
47 director of each of these departments may, with the concurrence
48 of the city manager, establish within the department functional
49 divisions.
