WHEREAS, The Parks and Community Services Department

15 WHEREAS, the City welcomes partnership opportunities that 16 enhance its ability to deliver parks and recreation services to the 17 community; and

WHEREAS, sponsorship opportunities provided by the City can
also support local businesses through exposure and direct engagement
with the public, resulting in improved brand recognition and exposure.

WHEREAS, the City is therefore willing to grant certain marketing and sponsorship privileges to local businesses in accordance with the City's Business Partnership and Naming Rights Policy, APM 3-6, and the terms and conditions outlined in the Sponsorship Agreement, attached hereto as Attachment 1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such policy, such sponsorship
 agreements for contributions valued in excess of \$7,500 are subject to
 Council approval by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City
 of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed
 to execute the Business Partnership Sponsorship Agreement
 substantially similar to that attached hereto as Attachment 1, providing
 for the sponsorship of the 2023 Outdoor Summer Movie Series by Ziply
 Fiber in exchange for payment of \$10,000.
