

RESOLUTION R-5582

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPOINTING A NEW REPRESENTATIVE TO THE KING COUNTY METROPOLITAN WATER POLLUTION ABATEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

1 WHEREAS, King County (the "County") has a Metropolitan Water
2 Pollution Abatement Advisory Committee (MWPAAC) to advise the
3 County Council and County Executive on matters related to the regional
4 wastewater treatment system; and

6 WHEREAS, the County's cities and local sewer districts are
7 members of MWPAAC, including the City of Kirkland; and

8
9 WHEREAS, each member agency must appoint a representative
10 to be a voting member of MWPAAC on behalf of their respective
11 agencies; and

13 WHEREAS, representatives must be appointed by the legislative
14 bodies of their respective agencies; and

16 WHEREAS, a recent staff change at the City has caused the need
17 to make a new appointment; and



19 WHEREAS, to facilitate the current appointment and subsequent
20 appointments if and when there are other staff changes at the City in
21 the future, it is recommended that the City not appoint a particular
22 person as its voting representative to the MWPAAC, but instead appoint
23 the Director of Public Works or the Director's designee;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City
26 of Kirkland as follows:

28 Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager
29 to appoint the Director of Public Works, or the Director's designee, to
30 be the City's voting representative on the King County Metropolitan
31 Water Pollution Abatement Advisory Committee.
