AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO VACATING A PORTION OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY BASED ON AN APPLICATION FILED BY JEFF BAKER, FILE NO. VC-97-71.

WHEREAS, by Resolution 4111, adopted on November 4, 1997, the City Council of the City of Kirkland established that it would vacate a portion of a right-of-way if certain conditions were met; and

WHEREAS, the conditions specified in Resolution No. 4111 have been satisfied.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The portions of public right-of-way situated in Kirkland, King County, Washington and described as follows:

That portion of the easterly 12 feet of 111th Avenue NE lying between NE 104th Street and NE 100th Street more readily described as the easterly 12 feet of the southerly 108.71 feet of the northerly 237.42 feet as measured from the centerline of NE 104th Street.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.

<u>Section 3.</u> A complete copy of this resolution, including Findings, Conclusions, and Recommendations adapted by reference, shall be certified by the City Clerk, who shall then forward the certified copy to the King County Department of Assessments.
