

RESOLUTION R-5586

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
ADOPTING THE 2023 SURFACE WATER MASTER PLAN.

1 WHEREAS, appropriate management of surface water in the city
2 of Kirkland achieves multiple goals, all of which improve the quality of
3 life for Kirkland community members; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the goals of the Surface Water Utility include flood
6 reduction, water quality improvement, infrastructure maintenance, and
7 fish habitat protection, which collectively are intended to improve safety,
8 reduce risk to public and private property, and enhance our natural
9 environment; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the most recent Surface Water Master Plan was
12 adopted in 2014, and the projects and programs in that plan have been
13 implemented; and
14

15 WHEREAS, the City intends to meet obligations for water quality
16 improvement under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System
17 (NPDES) Phase II Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Permit; and
18

19 WHEREAS, the City intends to meet obligations for water quality
20 improvement and fish habitat improvement under the Water Resources
21 Inventory Area (WRIA) 8 Lake Washington/Cedar/Sammamish
22 Watershed, Chinook Salmon Conservation Plan and Federal Endangered
23 Species Act; and

25 WHEREAS, the 2023 Surface Water Master Plan recommends
26 programs and projects for the next seven years of Surface Water Utility
27 Operation in accordance with the goals noted above.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City
30 of Kirkland as follows:

32 Section 1. The 2023 Surface Water Master Plan is adopted.
