

RESOLUTION R-5590

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITIES OF KIRKLAND AND REDMOND FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE IN THE 132<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE NE CORRIDOR.

1           WHEREAS, the 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue NE right-of-way (the "Corridor") is  
2 completely within the city limits of the city of Kirkland and owned and  
3 operated by Kirkland, and a portion of the Corridor abuts the city limits  
4 of the city of Redmond; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, each city has sanitary sewer infrastructure in or  
7 adjacent to the Corridor with many parcels not currently served by  
8 sanitary sewer service; and  
9

10           WHEREAS, it is in the interest of both Kirkland and Redmond  
11 (collectively, "Cities") to ensure that utility infrastructure in the Corridor  
12 is efficiently and sustainably planned; and  
13

14           WHEREAS, the Cities strive to deliver efficient and cost-effective  
15 sanitary sewer infrastructure and service for their respective ratepayers,  
16 and coordinating infrastructure in the Corridor will reduce infrastructure  
17 overlap and cost for ratepayers in both Cities; and  
18

19           WHEREAS, the Cities have evaluated an area along the Corridor  
20 and determined that certain current and future Kirkland sanitary sewer  
21 system customers and Redmond sanitary sewer system customers  
22 would be served better by connecting their side sewers to the other  
23 City's sewer system; and


25           WHEREAS, Chapter 39.34 RCW authorizes the parties to enter  
26 into an interlocal cooperation agreement to perform any governmental  
27 service, activity, or undertaking which each contracting party is  
28 authorized by law to perform.

30           NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City  
31 of Kirkland as follows:


33           Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed  
34 to execute on behalf of the City of Kirkland an interlocal agreement  
35 substantially similar to that attached as Attachment "A", which is entitled  
36 "Interlocal Agreement Between the Cities of Kirkland and Redmond for  
37 Sanitary Sewer Services in the 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue NE Corridor."
