

ORDINANCE 3689

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE SALARY FOR MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 3610.

WHEREAS, the salary for municipal judges must be established by ordinance;


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 3610 is hereby amended to read: The compensation for municipal judge as a contractor position shall not exceed a rate of \$8,278.00 per month. The salary for municipal judge as an employee position shall not exceed \$7,112 per month through December 31, 2001. Said employee salary may be effective from May 1, 1999; provided, however, that an employee salary will not be paid until after the effective date of an Employment Contract executed by the City Manager for the Municipal Judge position. The compensation for judge pro tem shall not exceed a rate of \$50 per hour.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.


