AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REENACTING KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 9.04.050 AND 9.05.051 RELATING TO RODENT CONTROL

WHEREAS, at the request of the Seattle King County Health Department, the City of Kirkland adopted Ordinance 3554 in 1996 to provide procedures for controlling the rodent population in the central downtown business district; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of that ordinance are due to sunset by the terms of that ordinance on September 30, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Health Department believes the provisions of 3554 help control the rodent population and have therefore requested that these provision remain in effect instead of being allowed to sunset,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Sections 9.04.050 and 9.04.051 are reenacted to read as they are currently written.

Section 2. Section 1 of this ordinance shall remain in effect until September 30, 2002, at which time it shall be deemed repealed unless the City Council reenacts it prior to that date


Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.


