AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING THE **BIENNIAL BUDGET FOR 2023-2024.**

1 WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proposed 2 adjustments to the Biennial Budget for 2023-2024 reflect revenues and 3 expenditures that are intended to ensure the provision of vital municipal 4 services at acceptable levels. 5
