1A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF2KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE3IN UNOPENED RIGHT-OF-WAY AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND4REQUESTED BY ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNER RD HOMES LLC.5

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to recognize that any rights the City may have to the land originally dedicated in 1891 as right-of-way abutting a portion of the plat of Supplementary Plat to Kirkland have been vacated by operation of law; and

WHEREAS, under Washington State's Non-User Statute, Laws
 of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, any county road that remained within
 county jurisdiction and unopened for five years after authority was
 granted for opening the same was statutorily vacated by operation of
 law; and

WHEREAS, the area that is the subject of this request was part
of an annexation to the City of Kirkland in 1967, with the relevant rightof-way having been unopened and remaining unopened; and

WHEREAS, in consideration for reimbursing the City administrative costs for reviewing the request, the City is willing to recognize the statutory vacation may have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the
City of Kirkland as follows:

28 <u>Section 1</u>. The City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby
 29 recognizes that the following described right-of-way may have been
 30 statutorily vacated by operation of law and the City relinquishes all
 31 interest that the City may have in that portion of right-of-way described
 32 as follows:

The east 30 feet of 114th Avenue NE, or whatever portion remains for
 recognition of possible vacation by this Resolution, abutting the west
 boundary of the following described property:

The west 15 feet of Lot 14 and all of Lots 15 and 16, Block 235 of
Supplementary Plat to Kirkland, according to the plat thereof, recorded
in Volume 8 of Plats, page 5, records of King County, Washington;
together with vacated alley adjoining said Lots; situate in the County of
King, State of Washington.

44 <u>Section 2</u>. This resolution does not affect any third party's rights 45 in the property, if any.
