

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SWIMMING POOL FEES AND REPEALING AND REENACTING SECTION 3.68.070 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 3.68.070 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. There is hereby created a new section of the Kirkland Municipal Code to be designated KMC 3.68.070, entitled "Swimming Pool Fees" and to read as follows:

3.68. 070 Swimming pool fees.

The fees for use of a swimming pool owned and operated by the City are as follows:

- (1) Open swim:
Child \$1.50
Adult \$1.50
- (2) Locker fee: \$0.25
- (3) Swim lessons:
\$4.50 per student per instruction period. An instruction period is one-half hour in length.

The Director of the Parks and Community Services Department may, in consultation with the Park Board, adjust the swimming pool fees. Any change in fees shall not become effective until a notice setting forth such changes has been posted at the pool for a period of not less than ten days.

Section 3. If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
