

RESOLUTION R-5599

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND TO CONTINUE TO PARTICIPATE AS A JOINT AGREEMENT CITY UNDER THE KING COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (HOME) CONSORTIUM.

1           WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has participated as a Joint  
2 Agreement City in the King County CDBG/HOME Consortium, governed  
3 by Interlocal Agreements since 2015; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, participating as a Joint Agreement City allows the  
6 City of Kirkland to receive funds in support of programs and projects that  
7 directly benefit our community, including but not limited to home repair,  
8 affordable housing, community facilities, public infrastructure, and  
9 human services; and

11           WHEREAS, King County requires that the City of Kirkland inform  
12 the County and HUD every three years of its intent to continue in the  
13 Consortium; and


15           WHEREAS, Parks and Community Services staff recommend  
16 that the City Council authorize the City Manager to convey the City's  
17 intent to continue to participate in the Consortium for the three-year  
18 period of 2024-2026.

20           NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the  
21 City of Kirkland as follows:

23           Section 1. The City Council supports the City's continued  
24 participation in the King County Consortium under a joint agreement for  
25 the three-year period of 2024-2026 and authorizes the City Manager to  
26 convey this intent to participate to King County and HUD.
