AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND AMENDING TITLE 16 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. A new section 16.04.230 is hereby added to the Kirkland Municipal Code to read as follows:

16.04.230 Extra unit of garbage.

"Extra unit of garbage" means an additional 32 gallon can/cart above a customer's designated level of service.

<u>Section 2</u>. Section 16.08.040 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.08.040 Garbage can required.

All occupants of residences and other dwelling units shall have and use a sufficient number of garbage cans, carts or plastic bags meeting the specifications of Section 16.04.120 to hold all of their garbage and ashes. Additional amounts of rubbish, bundled in ordinance units as herein defined, may be set out for collection. Hot ashes shall not be set out for collection. No garbage shall be placed in ordinance units other than plastic bags meeting the specifications of Section 16.04.120.

Section 3. Section 16.08.060 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.08.060 Garbage can-Weight.

No garbage can, when filled, shall weigh more than sixty-five pounds, and it shall be so packed that the contents thereof will dump out readily when the can is inverted.

Section 4. Section 6.12.030 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.12.030 Collection rates.

The rates to be charged for solid waste collection service in the city shall be as follows:

- (B) For each multifamily and nonresidential (commercial) customer the sum of six dollars and seventy-seven cents per month.
- <u>Section 5</u>. The garbage rates set forth in KMC 16.12.030 shall remain in force and effect until the rates set forth in this ordinance go into effect.
- <u>Section 6</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances, is not affected.
- Section 7. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication pursuant to Section 1.08.107, Kirkland Municipal Code in the summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council.

- (4) Wherever detachable containers are used having a capacity for which a rate has not been established, the Director of Public Works is authorized to establish a rate for such container, which shall be consistent with the ratio of the container capacity to rate charged for the rate herein established.
- (5) In addition to the collection rates established in subsections (1), (2), and (3) above, there shall be included a County Board of Health hazardous waste charge as follows:
- (A) For each single-family residential customer the amount of sixty cents per month;

PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 3826

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND AMENDING TITLE 16 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

SECTION 1. Adds a new section 16.04.230 defining Extra Unit of Garbage.

SECTION 2. Amends KMC Section 16.08.040 by adding carts as acceptable garbage cans.

SECTION 3. Amends KMC Section 16.08.060 by increasing maximum garbage can weights to 65 pounds.

SECTION 4. Amends KMC Section 16.12.030 by creating a new rate structure for solid waste collection.

SECTION 5. Provides that the garbage rates set forth in KMC 16.12.030 shall remain in force and effect until the rates set forth in the ordinance go into effect.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. Provides a severability clause for the ordinance.

SECTION 7. Authorizes publication of the ordinance by summary, which summary is approved by the City Council pursuant to Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code and establishes the effective date as five days after publication of summary.
