AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO CERTAIN POLICE DEPARTMENT FEES FOR FINGERPRINTING AND SERVING LEGAL PROCESS; AND AMENDING SECTION 5.74.020 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 5.74.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.74.020 Fee schedule established for payment to the city of Kirkland costs of certain services rendered by the city.

Persons seeking and obtaining the following services as provided by the city shall pay the following amounts for each instance such service is provided:

- (1) Police department, fingerprinting: fourfive dollars;
- (2) Police-department, serving legal process and similar papers (whether or not successful):-ten dollars;
- (32) Applicants for all entry level positions requiring qualifying examinations whether such positions are covered by civil service or otherwise shall reimburse the city for the per capita cost charged to the city by the appropriate testing agency for the giving of such qualifying examinations. Qualifying examinations may include physical agility testing or similar performance testing as well as written examinations. The fee shall be paid to the city at the time of filing application; provided, that a declaration of indigency by the applicant under this subsection shall excuse the imposition of the fee.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
