

ORDINANCE NO. 3907

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND AMENDING SECTION 16.12.030 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section I. Section 16.12.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.12.030 Collection rates.

The rates to be charged for solid waste collection service in the city shall be as follows:

(4) Wherever detachable containers are used having a capacity for which a rate has not been established, the director of public works is authorized to establish a rate for such container, which shall be consistent with the ratio of the container capacity to rate charged for the rate herein established.

(5) In addition to the collection rates established in subsections (1), (2) and (3) of this section, there shall be included a county board of health hazardous waste charge as follows:

(A) For each single-family residential customer the amount of sixty cents per month;

(B) For each multifamily and nonresidential (commercial) customer the sum of six dollars and seventy-seven cents per month.

Section 2. Effective date for new rates: The monthly rates established in this ordinance shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of December 1, 2003.

Section 3. The garbage rates set forth in KMC 16.12.030, which is amended by this ordinance, shall remain in force and effect until the rates set forth in this ordinance go into effect.


Section 4. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication pursuant to Section 1.08.107, Kirkland Municipal Code in the summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council.

SECTION 1. Makes amendments to update KMC Section
16.12.030.

SECTION 2. Establishes an effective date for new rates.


SECTION 3. Provides that the garbage rates set forth in KMC
16.12.030, which is amended by ordinance, shall remain in force and
effect until the rates set forth in the ordinance go into effect.

SECTION 4. Provides a severability clause for the ordinance.

SECTION 5. Authorizes publication of the ordinance by
summary, which summary is approved by the City Council pursuant to
Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code and establishes the
effective date as five days after publication of summary.
