## **ORDINANCE O-4878**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING THE BIENNIAL BUDGET FOR 2023-2024.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the proposed adjustments to the Biennial Budget for 2023-2024 reflect revenues and expenditures that are intended to ensure the provision of vital municipal services at acceptable levels.
