# ORDINANCE NO. 3947

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FINDING THE EXISTENCE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF ANTICIPATED REVENUES DURING THE BUDGETARY PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2004, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF SAME.

#### PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. <u>3947</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FINDING THE EXISTENCE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF ANTICIPATED REVENUES DURING THE BUDGETARY PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2004, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF SAME.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Provides a report of funds received in excess of anticipated revenues during the budgetary period beginning January 1, 2004, and authorizes the expenditure of same.
