## ORDINANCE No. 3991

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING THE FRANCHISE TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CABLE FRANCHISE NOW HELD BY COMCAST OF CALIFORNIA/COLORADO/TEXAS/WASHINGTON, INC.

WHEREAS, in Ordinance 3438, the City of Kirkland granted Tele-Vue Systems, Inc., d/b/a Viacom Cable, a cable franchise pursuant to a renewal request (the "Franchise"); and

WHEREAS, Comcast of California/Colorado/Texas/Washington, Inc. ("Comcast") is the present holder of the franchise granted by Ordinance 3438; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland and Comcast are presently negotiating a franchise renewal consistent with federal laws; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland and Comcast previously extended the term of the Franchise from November 27, 2004 through May 26, 2005 by Ordinance No. 3965A; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland and Comcast find it mutually beneficial to amend the existing Franchise to extend the term of the Franchise for an additional reasonable period of time in order to promote and facilitate an orderly franchise renewal process; and

WHEREAS, neither party waives any right which it enjoys under law as a result of agreeing to this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City of Kirkland finds that amending the Franchise to extend the Franchise term is in the interest of the public.

Section 2. The City of Kirkland hereby amends the Franchise to extend the term of the Franchise held by Comcast for a period of six (6) months, from and including May 27, 2005, through and including November 26, 2005.

Section 3. Within forty-five (45) days of the effective date of this ordinance, Comcast shall file with the City of Kirkland its written acceptance of this amendment extending the franchise term. If Comcast fails to do so, then this ordinance shall be voidable at the discretion of the City.

<u>Section 4.</u> If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, and the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances, is not affected.

<u>Section 5</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
