The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 16.12.030 of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC"), as last amended by Ordinance No. O-4817 §1 (2022), is hereby further amended to read as follows, with new text shown in underline and deleted text shown in strikethrough:

16.12.030 Collection rates.

One gray yard waste cart and one blue recycling cart is provided to each customer at no extra charge. The contractor will charge a fee for additional yard waste receptacles above the first set provided. The contractor will provide a 35- or 96-gallon recycling cart on request to new residents and those residents needing less or additional capacity than provided by the default 64-gallon recycling cart.

(5) In addition to the collection rates established in subsections (1), (2) and (3) of this section, there shall be included a hazardous waste charge adopted by King County Board of Health.

Section 2. Effective Dates of Rates.

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A. The garbage rates set forth in No. O-4817 (2022), which is amended by this ordinance, shall remain in force and effect until the new rates set forth in this ordinance go into effect.

B. The 2025 rates established in this ordinance shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of January 1, 2025.

C. The 2026 rates established in this ordinance shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of January 1, 2026.

Section 3. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication in the summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council.

PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 0-4883

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING SECTION 16.12.030 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION RATES FOR 2025 AND 2026.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Amends Section 16.12.030 of the Kirkland Municipal Code by amending solid waste collection rates.

SECTION 2. Provides an effective date for the rates.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Provides a severability clause for the ordinance.

SECTION 4. Authorizes publication of the ordinance by summary, which summary is approved by the City Council pursuant to Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code and establishes the effective date as five days after publication of summary.
