AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING SECTION 15.24.070 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CHANGE SEWER SYSTEM CUSTOMER RATES FOR 2025 AND 2026.

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 15.24.070 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance No. O-4819 §1 (2022), which contains a table that establishes the monthly sewer charge required to be paid to the City by customers of the Kirkland Sewer System, is hereby further amended to read as follows, with new rates shown under each applicable year:

10 (a) The monthly sewer charge required to be paid to the city by 11 customers of the Kirkland sewer system is established in Table 12 15.24.070.

(b) Annually, the city will calculate each single-family residential
 customer's average winter water consumption ("AWWC"). The resulting
 AWWC will be the basis for such customer's monthly sewer rate for the
 following calendar year.

(c) The director of public works is authorized to adopt administrative
 procedures for the purpose of administering the provisions of this
 chapter, including the procedure for annual calculation of average winter
 water consumption.

Section 2. Effective Dates of Rates.

A. The sewer rates set forth in Ordinance No. O-4819 (2022),
which is amended by this ordinance, shall remain in force and effect until
the rates set forth in this ordinance go into effect.

B. The 2025 monthly service and consumption rates established in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 3, number 6, and number 8 (whose annual billing cycle is December 1 through November 30) shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of December 1, 2024.

112 C. The 2025 monthly service and consumption rates established 113 in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing 114 cycles number 2, number 4, and number 5 (whose annual billing cycle 115 is January 1 through December 31) shall go into effect January 1, 2025.

D. The 2026 monthly service and consumption rates established in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 3, number 6, and number 8 (whose annual billing cycle is December 1 through November 30) shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of December 1, 2025.

E. The 2026 monthly service and consumption rates established in this ordinance for sewer customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 2, number 4, and number 5 (whose annual billing cycle is January 1 through December 31) shall go into effect January 1, 2026.

128 <u>Section 3</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to 129 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the 130 ordinance, or the application of the provision to other persons or 131 circumstances is not affected.

<u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days
 from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication
 in the summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by
 this reference approved by the City Council.
