

RESOLUTION R-5652

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING THE CITY OF KIRKLAND'S 2025-2026 ALLOCATION FOR THE REGIONAL CRISIS RESPONSE AGENCY (RCR) BUDGET.

1           WHEREAS, the Cities of Bothell, Kenmore, Kirkland, Lake  
2 Forest Park, and Shoreline have formed the Regional Crisis Response  
3 (RCR) Agency by interlocal agreement (ILA) to provide consolidated  
4 and expanded mobile crisis response services to the five-city region;  
5 and

7           WHEREAS, the City agrees that public safety and emergency  
8 response services, including crisis response awareness, support, and  
9 resource referral for community members in crisis with underlying  
10 behavioral health conditions is enhanced by the continued support of  
11 RCR; and

13           WHEREAS, RCR is in the process of adopting its biennial  
14 budget for 2025-2026; and


16           WHEREAS, the RCR Interlocal Agreement, to which the City is  
17 a party, requires that the City Council approves the City's allocation for  
18 RCR's budget before the RCR budget is adopted.

20           NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the  
21 City of Kirkland as follows:

23           Section 1. The City of Kirkland's 2025-2026 allocation for the  
24 Regional Crisis Response Agency (RCR) budget in the amount of  
25 \$1,728,747, as assessed by RCR and to be adopted in the City of  
26 Kirkland 2025-2026 budget, is approved.

28           Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in open  
29 meeting this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2024.
