

RESOLUTION R-5654

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING THE CITY OF KIRKLAND'S VEHICLE DONATION TO THE REGIONAL CRISIS RESPONSE AGENCY (RCR).

1 WHEREAS, the Cities of Bothell, Kenmore, Kirkland, Lake
2 Forest Park, and Shoreline have formed the Regional Crisis Response
3 (RCR) Agency by interlocal agreement to provide consolidated and
4 expanded mobile crisis response services to the five-city region; and
5

6 WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland recognizes that the continued
7 support of RCR enhances public safety and emergency response
8 services, including crisis response awareness, support, and resource
9 referral for community members in crisis with underlying behavioral
10 health conditions, is enhanced by the continued support of RCR; and
11

12 WHEREAS, the City purchased two vehicles for RCR use in
13 support of its crisis response program; and
14

15 WHEREAS, the RCR Interlocal Agreement states that title to
16 equipment is vested in the local entity that provides it, unless RCR
17 acquires the asset; and
18

19 WHEREAS, RCW 39.34.060 provides for the transfer of property
20 from the City to an entity created to operate a joint or cooperative
21 undertaking, such as RCR; and

23 WHEREAS, the City has completed its due diligence in
24 determining the specific actions needed to make the donation to RCR;


27 WHEREAS, the City and RCR agree that donation of two
28 vehicles to RCR is an appropriate next step now that RCR is a fully
29 operational non-profit organization.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the
32 City of Kirkland as follows:

34 Section 1. The City of Kirkland's vehicle transfer to RCR of two
35 vehicles, is approved.


