

RESOLUTION R-5667

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DECLARING THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE 2003 FIRE PUMPER TRUCK TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DONATE IT TO A QUALIFIED NONPROFIT.

WHEREAS, the City purchased a 2003 Spartan Gladiator Pumper truck for the Fire Department in 2003, VIN 4S7AT33983C043249. Fleet No. F612 ("Fire Truck F612"); and

WHEREAS, the useful life of Fire Truck F612 has expired, and the City purchased a replacement fire truck that was put into service on or about May of 2024:

WHEREAS, pursuant to KMC 3.86.020(b) and KMC 3.86.030(a)(4), the Fleet Manager and the Public Works Director deem Fire Truck F612 to be surplus to the City's needs at this time; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that Fire Truck F612 is surplus to the City's needs at this time; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Kirkland Municipal Code (KMC) 3.86.030(a)(4), the City Council is responsible for approving the method and disposition of surplus City property, vehicles, and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Fleet Manager and the Public Works Director recommend that Fire Truck F612 be donated to a local nonprofit agency pursuant to KMC 3.86.040(b)(7); and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the nonprofit company named First In Training & Education (FITE), a 501(c)(3) corporation located in Kirkland, which contracts with school districts to provide high quality preparatory training for high school juniors and seniors in the fields of firefighting and emergency medicine, is the appropriate company to receive this property.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Fire Truck F612 is declared surplus to the needs of the City.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to complete the transfer of Fire Truck F612 to FITE, as a donation of surplus property to a nonprofit company.
