

RESOLUTION R-5667

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DECLARING THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE 2003 FIRE PUMPER TRUCK TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DONATE IT TO A QUALIFIED NONPROFIT.

1 WHEREAS, the City purchased a 2003 Spartan Gladiator
2 Pumper truck for the Fire Department in 2003, VIN
3 4S7AT33983C043249, Fleet No. F612 ("Fire Truck F612"); and
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5 WHEREAS, the useful life of Fire Truck F612 has expired, and
6 the City purchased a replacement fire truck that was put into service on
7 or about May of 2024;
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9 WHEREAS, pursuant to KMC 3.86.020(b) and KMC
10 3.86.030(a)(4), the Fleet Manager and the Public Works Director deem
11 Fire Truck F612 to be surplus to the City's needs at this time; and
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13 WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that Fire Truck F612 is
14 surplus to the City's needs at this time; and
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16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Kirkland Municipal Code (KMC)
17 3.86.030(a)(4), the City Council is responsible for approving the method
18 and disposition of surplus City property, vehicles, and equipment; and

20 WHEREAS, the Fleet Manager and the Public Works Director
21 recommend that Fire Truck F612 be donated to a local nonprofit agency
22 pursuant to KMC 3.86.040(b)(7); and

24 WHEREAS, Council has determined that the nonprofit company
25 named First In Training & Education (FITE), a 501(c)(3) corporation
26 located in Kirkland, which contracts with school districts to provide high
27 quality preparatory training for high school juniors and seniors in the
28 fields of firefighting and emergency medicine, is the appropriate
29 company to receive this property.
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
31 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the
32 City of Kirkland as follows:
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34 Section 1. Fire Truck F612 is declared surplus to the needs of
35 the City.
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37 Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed
38 to complete the transfer of Fire Truck F612 to FITE, as a donation of
39 surplus property to a nonprofit company.
