

RESOLUTION R-5671

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING THE 2025-2026 ADMINISTRATIVE BUDGET AND WORK PROGRAM FOR A REGIONAL COALITION FOR HOUSING.

1           WHEREAS, King County and East King County cities, including  
2 the City of Kirkland partnered together to create A Regional Coalition for  
3 Housing (ARCH) to assist with preserving and increasing the supply of  
4 housing for low-and moderate-income households in the region; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, ARCH's member governments have supported  
7 development of a wide range of housing created and operated by local  
8 organizations and private developers that serve individuals, families,  
9 seniors, people experiencing homelessness, and people with special  
10 needs; and  
11

12           WHEREAS, the ARCH Executive Board has reviewed and  
13 approved the 2025-2026 Administrative Budget and Work Program; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, the interlocal agreement that created ARCH  
16 requires that the 2025-2026 Administrative Budget and Work Program  
17 be reviewed and approved by the each member council, including the  
18 Kirkland City Council; and  
19

20           WHEREAS, the creation of more affordable housing is a key  
21 component of the City's Work Program and a major goal of the City's  
22 recently-adopted Comprehensive Plan.


24           NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the  
25 City of Kirkland as follows:

27           Section 1. The 2025-2026 Administrative Budget of A Regional  
28 Coalition for Housing (ARCH), as adopted by ARCH's Executive Board,  
29 is approved.

31           Section 2. The ARCH Work Program for 2025-2026, as adopted  
32 by ARCH's Executive Board, is approved.
