## ORDINANCE NO. 2.

## AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THREE

PUBLIC PLACES OF POSTING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That the three public places for posting all ordinances passed by the Council of the Town of Kirkland and for posting all other public documents or notices required by law to be posted, shall be the following:-

At the entrance of the A. O. U. W. Hall, situated on the corner of Picadilly and Oxford Streets, being the meeting place of the Council of the Town of Kirkland.
2. The Post Office in the Town of Kirkland.

On the store known as that of the Kirkland Merchantile Company, situated near the ferry dock in the Town of Kirkland, and near the junction of the Houghton and Redmond roads.
