ORDINANCE NO. 3 .

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING OF A BOND BY THE TOWN TREASURER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That the Treasurer of the Town before he shall enter or proceed to discharge the duties of his office, shall qualify therefor by subscribing the constitutional oath and shall furnish a surety or guaranty bond in the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, for the faithful performance of his duties. Said bond to be approved by the Council and when approved, signed by the Clerk.

SECTION II.

The Treasurer shall be entitled to the commission and all fees now allowed him by law.

SECTION III.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and approval.
