

RESOLUTION. No 12

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

1. That it is the intention of the Town Council to order the improvement of Commercial Street by constructing a 4 ft. plank walk on the ^{partly as} South side thereof, from the easterly line of Lake Avenue to the westerly line of the State Road, a distance of 1175 feet, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with plans to be prepared by the Town Engineer.

2. That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the Town Council to be held in the Council Chamber in the Town Hall at the Town of Kirkland at 8 o'clock P M, on the 26 day of May, 1913, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

That the town Engineer shall submit to the Town Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

4. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.

5. That the town Clerk be and he is hereby directed to cause publication of this resolution in the manner required by law, said first publication to be at least fifteen (15) days prior to said date of hearing.
