RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
KIRKLAND.

*No. 22*

WHEREAS, in the development of the water system of the Town of Kirkland, as provided for in Ordinance No. 116 of said Town, it will be necessary to lay water pipes upon certain portions of County Roads in King County; now, therefore,

Be it Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland as follows:

1. That the Board of County Commissioners of the County of King, State of Washington be, and they are, hereby requested to grant unto the Town of Kirkland a franchise to permit the Town of Kirkland to lay watermains or pipes for conveying water for a municipal water supply for the Town of Kirkland along the following described County Roads, to-wit:

Commencing at the South line of Section Seventeen (17), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Five (5) East, W. M., being the intersection of the South line of Section Seventeen with roads Number Eighty-five (85) and Nine Hundred Thirty-five (935); thence continue in a Northerly direction along Road Number Eighty-five (85) to Road Number Nine Hundred Thirty-five (935); thence in a Northerly direction along Road Number Nine Hundred Thirty-five (935) to the intersection with Road Number Five Hundred Seventy-five; thence Northerly along roads Numbers Five Hundred Seventy-five (575), Four Hundred Fifty-six (456) and Three Hundred Seventy-two (372) to the South limits of the Town of Kirkland, said line being located approximately six hundred (600) feet, more or less, South of the East and West center-line of Section Eight (8), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Five (5) East, W. M.

2. That the Mayor of the Town of Kirkland be, and he is, hereby authorized, empowered and directed to make application in the name of the Town of Kirkland for such franchise.
