RESOLUTION NO. 101

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of Washington is now preparing plats of the shore lands and harbor areas in front of and adjacent to the City of Kirkland,

AND WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has acquired by purchase or otherwise all of the up-lands west of Lake Avenue in Blewett's 1st Addition to the City of Kirkland, and all of the up-lands and shore lands covered by the extension of Juanita Street, Fleet Street, Waverly Street, Market Street, Jackson Street, Salano Avenue, New Hampshire Street, Commercial Street and in front of all of Crane and Dickey's Addition, all as shown in deeds and maps, copies of which were heretofore forwarded to the said State Land Commissioner,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the said State Land Commissioner of the State of Washington be requested to make reservations for the City of Kirkland over and across the shore lands and harbor areas in front of the aforesaid mentioned tracts for the uses of the City of Kirkland under authority granted him in Chapter 50 of the Laws of 1917.
