

RESOLUTION 102

Be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland:

Section 1. That this council will proceed to improve Waverly street between Park street and the Alley which comes into Waverly street at the south-east corner of Lot 31, in Block 7, Map of Kirkland, by grading and putting in cement sidewalk on the north side of said Waverly street and such other work as may be necessary thereto, including drains and crossings at the intersection of Park street and Waverly street.

Section 2. That all persons desiring to object thereto appear and present such objections at a meeting of the Town Council to be held for that purpose at the council chambers on the 16th day of February, 1925, at 8 o'clock p. m.

Section 3. That the engineer now in the employ of the Town of Kirkland be instructed to submit to the council at or prior to said date the estimated cost and expense of such improvement and a statement of the aggregate of the assessed valuation of the real estate, exclusive of improvements, within said district according to the valuation last placed upon it for the purpose of general taxation, together with a diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts, and parcels of land and other property which will be specially benefited thereby and the estimated amount of the cost and expense of such improvement to be borne by each lot, tract, or parcel of land or other property.

Section 4. That this council will create an improvement district to be known as L. I. D. No. 72, embracing the property set forth in section 1, of this ordinance to provide payment of the improvement by the method
