

RESOLUTION NO. 103

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of Kirkland grant to the Matzen Woolen Mills, a corporation, an easement on Lake Avenue, beginning at a point 251 feet North of the intersection of Burlington Street and Lake Avenue taking in a strip 10 feet wide on the West side of the said Lake Avenue for a distance of approximately 60 feet, for the purpose of erecting a water tank by the said Matzen Woolen Mills.

That at any time the said Town of Kirkland deems the use of said street necessary or convenient for the public use the Matzen Woolen Mills agree to remove said water tank from off of the said Lake Avenue.

That said easement to run for a period of ten years unless sooner revoked by operation of law or by act of the Council of the Town of Kirkland as aforesaid.
