

RESOLUTION R-5683

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING PARTICIPATION BY THE CITY IN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH PARTICIPATING LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WITHIN WATER RESOURCE INVENTORY AREA 8 (WRIA 8) FOR SALMON RECOVERY PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, chapter 39.34 RCW authorizes the City of Kirkland to enter interlocal agreements with other governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, Puget Sound Chinook salmon, including the Water Resource Area 8 (WRIA 8) Cedar and Sammamish populations, were listed as threatened under the Endangered Species Act (ESA) in 1999; and

WHEREAS, 28 local governments in WRIA 8 partner through an interlocal agreement to jointly fund implementation of the WRIA 8 Plan through 2025 to advance their shared interest in and responsibility for addressing long-term watershed planning and conservation of aquatic ecosystems and floodplains for purposes of implementing the WRIA 8 Plan and improving watershed health; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is located within the watershed designated as the Lake Washington/Cedar/Sammamish Watershed by the State of Washington, and participation in the WRIA 8 salmon recovery process is in the best interests of the City and its residents and is consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland values ecosystem health; water quality improvement; flood hazard reduction; open space protection; and maintaining a legacy for future generations, including commercial, tribal, and sport fishing, quality of life, and cultural heritage; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland supports cooperation at the WRIA level to set common priorities for actions among partners, efficient use of resources and investments, and distribution of responsibility for actions and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the WRIA 8 partners recognize participating in the ILA and implementing priorities in the WRIA 8 Plan demonstrates their commitment to proactively working to address the Endangered Species Act listing of Chinook salmon; and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council on June 21, 2005, adopted the WRIA 8 Chinook Salmon Conservation Plan, and on March 6, 2018, adopted the 2017 update to the WRIA 8 Plan, which has the purpose of preserving, protecting, and restoring habitat with the intent to recover listed species, including sustainable, genetically diverse, harvestable populations of naturally spawning Chinook salmon, and which recognizes that implementation of this plan is an integral part of the WRIA 8 salmon recovery process that supports implementation of the Puget Sound Partnership Action Agenda for recovery of the Puget Sound; and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council on November 8, 2006, adopted Resolution R-4612 approving a similar interlocal agreement for salmon recovery that expired on December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council on October 6, 2015, adopted Resolution R-5151 approving a similar interlocal agreement for salmon recovery that expires on December 31, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Kirkland an Interlocal Agreement in a form substantially similar to that attached as Exhibit "A," which is entitled "Interlocal Agreement for Chinook Salmon Conservation Planning for the Watershed Basins within Water Resource Inventory Area 8."
