RESOLUTION R-5684

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE KING COUNTY SEXUAL ASSAULT RESOURCE CENTER TO CREATE A PILOT PROGRAM FOR 2025-2026 THAT PROVIDES A SEXUAL ASSAULT LEGAL ADVOCATE DEDICATED TO SERVING SURVIVORS IN KIRKLAND AND EDUCATING THE KIRKLAND COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, everyone in the Kirkland community deserves to live in a safe and supportive environment where they are treated with respect; and

WHEREAS, while many sexual assaults go unreported, the Kirkland Police Department wrote 47 sex offense case reports in 2022, 54 in 2023, and 34 in 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to combating sexual violence in all its forms, to ensuring that prevention and education resources are available in the Kirkland community, and to making progress in preventing sexual abuse, assault, and harassment; and

WHEREAS, the King County Sexual Assault Resource Center (KCSARC) is a designated Community Sexual Assault Program specializing in sexual assault advocacy for survivors; and

WHEREAS, KCSARC offers comprehensive trauma-focused crisis and advocacy services, including crisis intervention and case management, connecting survivors to mental health treatment and legal advocacy to navigate the criminal and civil legal system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland currently provides human services grant funding to KCSARC, and this funding is pooled with contributions from other King County cities for shared access to the full suite of sexual assault survivor support services provided by KCSARC; and

WHEREAS, this pooled funding approach prioritizes allocating resources based on demand, which can result in Kirkland survivors of sexual assault receiving a lower level of service than needed, depending on the caseloads of KCSARC advocates over time; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to offer a new level of service to Kirkland survivors of sexual assault by providing more immediate support and better access to KCSARC's comprehensive wrap-around services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also desires to provide the community with more education and prevention resources related to sexual assault; and

WHEREAS, the City Council set aside \$200,000 in the City's 2025-2026 biennial budget to initiate a pilot program with KCSARC to fund a sexual assault legal advocate position dedicated to providing victim support and community education services in Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, while City staff would typically procure services through a request for proposals, here the City Council authorized the City Manager to negotiate directly with KCSARC given their unique program status, the nature of their work, and the City's needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Kirkland an agreement that is substantially similar to that attached to this resolution as Exhibit A, contracting with the King County Sexual Assault Resource Center to create a 2025-2026 pilot program that will provide a dedicated sexual assault legal advocate to serve survivors of sexual assault in Kirkland.
