

RESOLUTION NO. 111

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

Section 1: That it is the intention of the Town Council to order the improvement of *Commercial Street by laying a six inch water main between Lake Avenue and State aid Road*

and doing such other work as may be necessary thereto in accordance with the plans prepared by the Engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2: That all persons desiring to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the Town Council to be held in the Council chambers of the Town of Kirkland at 8 o'clock P.M. *May 18* ~~April 20~~, 1925, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said proposed improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

Section 3: The Engineer in the employ of the said Town shall, in the manner provided by law, submit to the Town Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

Section 4: That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable thereof, as provided by law.
