R E S O L U T I O N. NO. 106

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

Section 1: That it is the intention of the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland to order the improvement of:-

" Massachusetts Street between Oxford and Market streets by grading and gravling, putting in proper culverts

and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith all in accordance with the plans prepared by the engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2: That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the Town Council to be held at the Council Chambers in the Town of Kirkland at 8 o'clock P.M. on the 18 day of ^{May} ~~March~~, 1925, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

Section 3: That the engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland shall, in the manner provided by law, submit to the Town Council at or prior to said date, all data and information to be required by law to be submitted.

Section 4: That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT sealed bids will be received by the undersigned Town Clerk of the Town of Kirkland, for the improvement of Kirkland Avenue from Lake Avenue on the North side and from Blau's Chervolet Co. garage property on the South side to the State Aid Road, by putting in cement sidewalks and curbs and the State Aid Road on the North and East Sides to the City Limits by putting in cement sidewalks, with culverts and crossings and gradeing and crossings and such other work as may be necessary thereto, in accordance with Ordinance Number 247 of said Town and the plans and specifications of the Town engineer which are now on file and open to inspection with the Town Clerk.

Said bids will be received up to 5:00 o'clock P.M. May 18, 1925 at the office of the undersigned Town Clerk. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check for ten per cent of the amount thereof made payable to the Town of Kirkland and the same to be forfeited to the Town in case the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract and furnish the bond required and provided for.

The successful bidder will be required to enter into a written contract pursuant to said bid and furnish a good and sufficient bond to the said Town conditioned for the faithful performance thereof, in an amount equal to the contract price for said work, all within ten days after the acceptance of said bid.

The Town Council reserves the right to refuse any and all bids.

Special attention is called to the number of hours constituting a days work under the State law.

The successful bidder will also be required to make all ~~\$\$\$~~ payments to the State of Washington, which may be required by reason of the "Workmens Compensation Act."
