

RESOLUTION NO. 113

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION 1: That it is the Intention of the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland to Order the Improvement of Michigan Ave. Between Oxford and Market, be grading, graveling, and proper culverts and such other work as may be necessary thereto; and by putting in cement sidewalks on the North side of Michigan Ave., between Oxford and Bold St., and such other work as may be necessary thereto in connection therewith, all in accordance with the plans prepared by the Town Engineer.

SECTION 2: That all persons who may desier to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the Town Council to be held in the Council Chambers of the Town of Kirkland at 8 o'clock P.M. June 22, 1925, which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

SECTION 3: That the Engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland shall, in the manner provided by law, submit to the Town Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information to be required by law to be submitted.

SECTION 4: That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.
