

RESOLUTION NO. 129

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND

SECTION 1. That it is the intention of the Town Council to order the improvement of:- Bond Street from the west side of Market Street to the west side of Park Street by grading and graveling.

and such other work as may be necessary thereto, in accordance with the plans and specifications of the Engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland.

SECTION 2. That all persons desiring to object thereto are hereby notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the Town Council to be held in the Council Chambers of the town of Kirkland at 8 o'clock P.M. on the 15th of November 1925 which time and place is hereby fixed for hearing all matters relating to said improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

SECTION 3. That the Engineer in the employ of said Town, shall in the manner provided by law, submit to the Town Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

SECTION 4. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne and assessed against the property liable therefore as provided by law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT SEALED BIDS WILL BE RECEIVED by the undersigned Town Clerk of the Town of Kirkland for the ~~furnishing~~ improvement of Commercial street by laying of six inch water main on Commercial street from Lake Avenue to the State Aid Road in accordance with Ordinance 249 and amendments thereto and the following streets: from Oxford on Jefferson to Market to connect with the new main on Columbia, from Oxford on Washington to Market, from Columbia on Market to Marion, from Market to Juanita on Spring, from Spring to Marion on Juanita, from Juanita to Market on Marion and such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith in accordance with Ordinance No. 272 of said town and the furnishing of six inch water main for the same with fittings ~~fixtures~~ according to the plans and specifications which are on file with the Town Clerk. The said bids will be received up to five o'clock P. M. January 18, 1926, at the office of the Town Clerk. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check for 10% of the amount of the bill, made payable to the Town of Kirkland, and the same to be forfeited to the said Town in case the successful bidder failed to enter into a contract and furnish a bond as required and provided for: all payments by the Town of Kirkland to be made by bonds on the L.I.Ds. The successful bidder will be required to enter into a written contract pursuant to said bid and furnish a good and sufficient bond to the said Town conditioned for the faithful performance thereof in an amount equal to the contract price of said material, all within ten days after acceptance of said bid.
