

RESOLUTION. NO 131

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

1. That it is the intention of the said Town Council to order, the improvement of *Oxford Street from south end of Arlington to the north end of Hillside Street by grading, curbing, sidewalks, sidewalks on both sides of Oxford Street, and putting in granite curbs* and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with the plans prepared by the engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland.

2: That all persons who may desire to object thereto are hereby required and notified to appear and present such objections at a meeting of the Town Council to be held in the Council Chambers in the town of Kirkland on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1926, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., which time and place is hereby fixed for the hearing of all matters relating to said improvement, and all objections thereto, and for determining the method of payment for said improvement.

3: The Engineer, in the employ of said Town, shall, ~~appear~~ in the manner provided by law submit to the Town Council, at or prior to said date, all data and information required by law to be submitted.

4: That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be borne by and assessed against the property liable therefor, as provided by law.
